



From the Chirurgon

Chirurgeons Note

In this missive, I would like to bring up a topic I believe is underappreciated in the SCA, that of head injuries in SCA combat. A concussion is the most common head injury in contact sports such as SCA fighting, and is defined as any change in the way your brain normally works following a blow to the head. It doesn't necessarily have to involve a loss of consciousness. Even the feeling of "getting your bell rung," from a head shot can be considered a concussion. It has been recognized that repeated minor concussions, or returning to significant physical and mental activity before the brain has had a chance to recover from injury, can lead to development of post-concussion syndrome, which may result in fatigue, headaches, unstable balance, or difficulty concentrating for days, months, or longer following the injury.

You can consider that you may have had a concussion if you experience nausea, confusion, dizziness and unsteadiness, sensitivity to light or sound, or feeling of sluggishness or mental fogginess following a head blow. As surgeons, we can only make suggestions, not ban fighters from the field, but it is generally recommended that anyone who is suspected of having a concussion be removed from fighting, and also refrain from any heavy physical and mental activity, until the symptoms have completely resolved. It is best to refrain from fighting for the rest of the day, and if even minor symptoms persist for more than 15 minutes, get evaluated by your health care professional. For more serious symptoms such as vomiting, confusion, or loss of consciousness, it is recommended to be evaluated at the local hospital right away.

The basic rules for the Dirty Half Dozen Donation Derby

* All entrants must create 6 items based on a theme that are suitable for largesse

- 6 items suitable for a specific time period
- 6 children's toys
- 6 socks would not be suitable as that is only 3 pairs

* All entries must be tagged and ready to be gifted the day of the competition.

* Items should not have heraldry on them as they are meant to be given to other areas.

* Judging is done by the populace. Each entrant display will have a cup placed next to it and anyone may put a provided token into the accompanying cup to denote their choice.

* The entrant with the most tokens in their cup at the end of the day chooses one item from any one of the other entries as a prize. Each entrant then chooses from the remaining entries according to how many tokens they received (largest to smallest number). Each entry may only be chosen once as a prize.

* The remaining 5 items from each entry will be given to Their Highness' of Cynagua.
