From the EQ Minister

From your Equestrian Officer

Well, there is mud everywhere and the horses all look like hairy yaks but I promise you that spring is coming! With it comes a renewed interest in equestrian practices around the Principality.

Please come to the eq practices – even if you don't ride. Spectators are appreciated! Even more appreciated are folks who, while they may not want to ride, are willing to support the equestrian arts by being Ground Crew. It is tiresome to have to keep getting on and off your horse to re-set the heads and reeds and rings; to pick up dropped swords and crests and lances; to go find arrows that missed their targets! Being Ground Crew is easy. In the West, you just have to read the West Kingdom EQ Handbook, be observant, able to act safely around horses, and listen to your equestrian marshal!

There will be three areas holding eq. practice this year – Canale (see Mistress Else), Golden Rivers (see Vscts Mistress Gwendwyn) and Silver Desert (see Mistress Siobhan). Equestrian events/practices are posted in the West Kingdom Eq. Facebook page (**west kingdom equestrian group**) and on the Golden Rivers Eq. Facebook page (**golden rivers area equestrian events and practices**).

DATES so far:

Canale – Feb 11 and Mar 4

Golden Rivers Mar 18

Silver Desert – May 19 (it snows as late into spring at our end of things, sigh)

There will be horses at May Coronet in Quincy,

CA!!!!!! Viscountess Mistress Gwendwyn is the Planner of EQ Activities! If you want to ride at an event, you must be authorized. PLEASE talk to one of us about getting authorized BEFORE May Coronet! At this point, I do not know if rentals will be available but getting authorized is still the first step!

Stick Horses at Coronet – we can have another stick horse race but, riders should plan on bring their own stick horses!!! An old tube sock and an old broom stick or whatever, some string to shape the head from the neck, pillow stuffing for shaping, some felt to make ears, some trim for a mane, some paint for eyes and nose --- ta da!!!! Stick Horse!

Also at Coronet – I will hold some discussions and classes about horses in period and I will hold a basic horse handling/owning (aka "my 5 year old wants a pony!!! What do I do?!?!?) /etc. seminar.

As always, I am happy to talk All Things Horse and the drop of a (horse) shoe.

From the Culinary & Herbalist Guild

Yes, I am doing both guilds in one this time around. Why? Because the main items I use for any recipes, gifts, presents, or whatever, I try to grow in my garden. So I designate our garden areas for culinary, medicinal, dyeing. Since a lot of plants have multiple uses, this is a good thing for folks like me.

Getting your plant lists together for this coming spring/summer? Are you getting a garden area ready? What types of plants or seedlings are on your list? Culinary? Medicinal? Dyeing? Can't make up your mind yet, like me? I get around ten plus seed company catalogs in the fall alone and go through them all, literally page by page, making notes for each catalog. I don't order from every catalog, rather I use three or four seed companies and I do get some plants from a few nurseries.

I set some new goals for this year. Grow items for a first aid kit, do a pet first aid kit, learn to prepare salves and ointments. Grow more yarrow plants, and put them around our shop areas, should they be needed; yes, our hobbies tend to get us cut up at times. So part of the catalog researches was specifically for these needs.

Next step is deciding where all the plants/seedling will be put in a few short months. Remember to move plantings around in different areas of your garden annually. Planting plants in the same area in consecutive years will deplete the soils, even with adding supplements to the soils. We do composting, along with time release fertilizers for some plants, but I primarily prefer to use the compost.


