

Hola Cynagua Artisans!

Have you thought about what makes an A&S Champion in Cynagua? Maybe you have seen the cool medallion of the Lumens Cynagua and thought, "Wow! I would like one of those". Well, you can earn a Lumens Cynagua, but you need to plan for this now. Here is the Law:

Article V: Traditions

Section 1 – Arts/Sciences Championship

The Minister of Arts & the Minister of Sciences, acting in concert, will be responsible for scheduling a series of eight (8) competitions (four art and four science competitions) over the course of the year to determine the individual with the foremost skill in the medieval Arts and Sciences.

Starting with Spring Coronet and ending with Winter Investiture, an Arts competition, as well as a Sciences competition will be held at each Principality event. These will serve as the basis for the yearly Arts & Sciences Championship, or "Lumen Cynagua." To be eligible for the Championship, a competitor must enter a minimum of four (4) of these eight (8) competitions. While multiple items may be entered in a competition, only the highest score in each competition will count toward the Championship. The competitor with the highest total of four scores will be

named Champion. The competition will be open and limited to those residing in the Principality throughout the entire year. The winner will be awarded the "Lumen Cynagua" in court at the Spring Coronet following the last competition, i.e. Winter Investiture, and styled Champion of Arts and Sciences as well as the Principality Artisan for the following year.

This year, no one is eligible, but I am trying to give you a heads up! Next year, our competitions will be strictly to bring your projects and submit them at all four opportunities. Each competition will need to have its own project, but by showing your Championship skills (you don't have to win all the time) you can earn this accolade. So, start preparing to show your art at May Coronet!

And fly with the Bonny Black Swan


When I answered the call



Friendly to green horses. New to horses? This is a great, supportive environment to come try things. Green horses and beginning riders are welcome to participate.

There is no fee to attend. If you bring an equid, there is a \$10 Haul in fee payable to Double N Ranch.

We are trying something a little different this year, reviving an older practice format.

The first part of the day will be 20-30 minute semi-private riding lessons with Else working on horsemanship and equitation topics. Lesson start times mean tacked up and ready to ride.

If you would like a lesson, please contact Else. You are responsible for arranging for a horse or mule. That can mean arranging for rentals, bringing your own, or asking one of the horse owners in advance if you can borrow one of theirs.

Later as a group, we will work on games, open sparring and other activities. Group times will be announced about a week before the practice, once lesson times are set.

Only Volunteers approved by Bjorn or Seamus are permitted to attend the Friday Demo.


